

"Music is my Aeroplane"

– youth exchange on exploring and practicing empowerment, participation, intercultural communication and feeling European citizen of young people with diverse cultural background by education through music with special focus on visual arts and web design

13-21 August 2019, Kiskunfélegyháza, Hungary

Themes of the youth exchange:

Music for empowerment of culturally diverse young people – who, what, when, why, how? – self - esteem and self – confidence;

Music for participation – motivation, involvement, communication skills, responsibility, management skills, etc. ;

Music for culture mixture – ambiguity, cultural identity, intercultural communication;

Music for Europe – visual arts and web design as tools for European citizenship: active participation in local community and experience the feeling being European.

The overall aim of the youth exchange to practice how music with special focus on visual arts and web design can be a great tool for empowerment of culturally diverse young people, to motivate and involve them into local and European youth work activities and through these decreasing their ambiguity, strengthening their cultural identity and making them capable for intercultural communication in order to be able to be active members of their societies and feeling responsible part of European Union.

Objectives which can lead us to achieve our overall aim:

- To experience and practice music as educational tool by using visual arts and web design for enhancing self – confidence and self – esteem of culturally diverse young people;
- To motivate and involve them into local and European youth work activities in order to explore their cultural identity;
- To practice intercultural communication skills through music and experiencing the feeling as being important part of the society;
- To invent youth exchanges based on the needs of culturally diverse young people by using music as educational tool with special focus on visual arts and web design and according to the proposals of KA1 Mobility projects for young people and youth workers in Erasmus + programme.

The methodology of the youth exchange:

The youth exchange will be based on methodology of non – formal education. It will be based on the needs of the participants and provide space for participants to share and explore the themes of the youth exchange. Some methods we will plan to use: individual, pair and mixed group work, drawings, montage/collage, group discussions, brainstorming, role play, dancing, singing, playing in instruments, using web design, painting, sculpture, printmaking, design, crafts, photography, video, filmmaking and architecture,



visit to good practice project, idea and project development, etc. During the youth exchange, education through music will be combined with visual arts as drawing, painting, sculpture, architecture, photography, film, printmaking and the decorative arts of ceramics, furniture and interior design, jewelry making, metal crafting, wood working and as next step to put offline educational tools into online one by using and practising web design for making it more open educational resource.

Who can participate in the youth exchange? young people aged between 14 – 18 years old with 1 group leader older than 25 years old and there is no upper age limit.
